

Modern Slavery Act Statement

Introduction

This statement is made in accordance with the provisions of the Modern Slavery Act 2015. We are committed to doing what we can to ensure there is no slavery or human trafficking in our business or our supply chains, to identify high risk areas and take positive action.

Organisational Structure

Ickenham Travel Group was formed in 1970. At the time it was a single company however it now brings together several entities under that title.

Our companies employ over 115 staff. Our joint annual turnover exceeds £36 million (the minimum threshold for companies which must publish this statement).

Our Commitment

ITG is taking steps to mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking by:

- Reviewing contracts with existing suppliers. If potentially high-risk contracts are identified these may be reviewed prior to renewal
- Including in new contracts an obligation to address the requirements of the Modern Slavery Act
- Updating policies and procedures to take account of the Modern Slavery Act
- Making all relevant pre-employment checks prior to employing staff. We use fair and transparent recruitment processes and will ensure the recruitment agencies we work with comply with these requirements in the provision of agency staff
- Regularly reviewing our employment terms and conditions
- Encouraging reporting of serious concerns related to our own activities or supply chain.
- This statement has been approved by the Executive Team and applies to all organisations within the Ickenham Travel Group. It will be reviewed annually.
